Job Description – Shop Mechanic

We are a 100% employee-owned company offering excellent compensation and benefits.

Pumping Services, Inc. is a stocking distributor and service facility for the world's leading manufacturers of equipment used in the treatment and transfer of water, wastewater and other fluids. We serve the municipal, industrial, construction, commercial and utility markets in New Jersey, New York and surrounding areas.

The services we offer include shop and field service, sewage bypass and equipment rentals for dewatering and other pumping applications.

The position we are accepting applications for is Shop Mechanic. The shop mechanic will work in our shop repairing customer equipment brought in for repair and maintaining our own equipment which we rent. The types of equipment worked on are pumps, generators and sometimes other items. The pumps are electric submersible, diesel driven, gasoline driven, air operated among others.

Pumping Services, Inc. does not require that the applicant have specific experience repairing pumps but it does expect some mechanical experience and the ability to learn quickly. The successful candidate will be sent to manufacturer's product schools as part of the training process.

The Shop Mechanic, like all our employees, does not have a limited job description but is expected to do the work required to meet our customer's needs including working overtime.

A rotating group of service employees carry cell phones and stand by to work in order that we may give our customer's 24-hour service. These employees are compensated for this and all drivers, mechanics and technicians take turns being on standby for one-week period at a time.

All applicants should have a valid driver's license in their state of residency and a clean driving record.

Other essential job tasks include:

- Accurate completion of paperwork so that it is filled out in a way that the customer and we can understand.
- Understand and work with 3 phase electric power.
- Some agility and heavy lifting required in handling equipment.
- Repair pumps
- Good reading skills in order to understand equipment manuals.
- Driving and operating all Pumping Services, Inc. vehicles including roll-offs, flatbeds and service vehicles. CDL is not necessary.

After 90 days you'll have access to benefits that include:
